EAS PARTICIPANTS— The RMT must be rebroadcast within 60 minutes of reception. EAS Activations and the NPT must be rebroadcast within 15 minutes of reception.

EAS Participants who receive a False EAS activation must report that activation to the FCC. Reports must be sent to the FCC Operations Center at FCCOPS@fcc.gov within 24 hours of determining that the activation was a False EAS activation. The report must include the date and time of the alert and any details noted by the Participant. For more information, see the 2021 Nevada EAS Plan.

AUTHORIZED ALERT ORIGINATORS—You will receive an email with detailed instructions for sending your Required Monthly Test. All tests and activations are to be sent on your agency CAP program.
